DESIGN

- The geometric-style appearance complements the futuristic nature of the building
- Each panel was designed and assigned to a specific location on the façade to fit the architect's brief
- Rooftop screening louvres match the colour of the new state-of-the-art facility

MANUFACTURE

- The panels were anodised in the shade 'Golden Splendour'
- Anodising provides the panels with long-term resistance to weathering
- Each panel was fully perforated, partially perforated or solid

INSTALLATION

- Over 500 gold panels clad the new facility
- Louvres were supplied and installed on the building's rooftop
- Project installed on time in full
